President's Message

The Pasadena Chamber has devoted a significant amount of our energy and resources to building an effective career education and college preparedness program for students in the Pasadena Unified School District. The support we provide for work-based learning curriculum has a strong, positive impact on young people in our community.

To sustain that effort, once our grant funds run out, the Chamber is creating a charitable non-profit, the Pasadena Chamber of Commerce Foundation. As a 501c3 tax exempt corporation, the Foundation will be governed by its own Board of Directors, working with by-laws specific to the Foundation, and undertake its own fundraising efforts. Foundation fundraising will support the Chamber's work-based learning activities.

If we are to sustain our efforts to support work-based learning in our local public schools, and expand our efforts, we cannot rely on money from local school districts. We need to develop independent funding sources. Creating the non-profit will give us the ability to raise money independently through grants and direct donation appeals.

Having the Foundation, however, will allow us to independently pursue grant funding and other opportunities not currently available to the Chamber. Donations to the Foundation will be fully tax-deductible for the donor.

Amy Foell, the Chamber workforce development manager, will lead these efforts as part of her responsibilities.

The Chamber will continue to host our existing events and activities, and fully support our membership, as we have in the past. Even with an added emphasis on work-based learning and support for initiatives such as our \$\int ixth Grade \psi ents\$ financial literacy program for middle schoolers, we will continue to serve our members with an aggressive calendar of programs and activities. In fact, the Chamber continues to expand our programming in support of our members.

Pasadena Chamber Inaugural Gala July 7th at Langham Huntington Hotel Pasadena




